Thank you for your entry to the Cambridge Champs Junior Sculling Head

Please ensure that your competing crews and coxes read and understand the Safety Plan and Competitor Information.

All non-Cambridge clubs wishing to compete must have previously attained permission to do so from a local club or have confirmed through Jen Bromley (race organiser) a host club.

Clubs boating from Emmanuel must contact Peter Twitchett (petetwitchett@aol.com). Clubs boating from Clare, Pembroke or Queens' boathouses must have received confirmation from Jen Bromley (events.secretary@championrowing.org). Clubs boating from Cambridge City RC must contact Jack Lawlor-Anderson (ccrccaptain@gmail.com).

Clubs boating from Cambridge City RC will need to park cars/trailers in the surrounding roads. Parking is unrestricted on Sundays. We recommend Aylestone Road for trailer parking (CCRC trailer is parked on this road).

To find your boating area:

CCRC is found at the end of Kimberley Road. At the Elizabeth Way roundabout, take Chesterton Road, turn left into De Freville Avenue and then take the second right onto Aylestone Road (we recommend leaving your trailer here and carrying boats to the river for rigging). Take the 1st left onto Kimberley Road and continue to the end and the boathouses. CCRC boathouse is on your left of the access way to the river.

Emmanuel College Boathouse, Clare College Boathouse and Pembroke College Boathouse are found at the bottom of Manhattan Drive. As with accessing CCRC, from the Elizabeth Way roundabout, take Chesterton Road, turn left into De Freville Avenue but take the fourth left into Aylestone Road. Continue to the end and turn right onto Belvoir Road. Follow this road around 2 sharp corners. Ahead of you will be Cutter Ferry footbridge and to the left of this is the Emmanuel College Boathouse gate. To the right is Pembroke and then Clare. Please DO NOT park or drive trailers across the grass at these boathouses. The grassy areas can be used for rigging, boat storage and picnicing throughout the day. Please make sure that trailers and cars do not block access to the road behind the boathouses.

Queens' College Boathouse is found at the bottom of Trafalgar Road. At the Elizabeth Way roundabout, take Chesterton Road. Just past the Light Blue Cycle Company (and the Old Spring Pub), turn left onto Trafalgar Road which ends at the river. Codes for the changing rooms will be provided to clubs boating from here.
